**RESPONSES TO QUESTIONS**

1. Please clarify the AVI's requirements for both reader/antenna and transponder. Page 25 of Exhibit A states the Transponder to operate on the 2.435 to 2.465 GHz, which is Microwave technology, but the AVI reader and Antenna specifies Frequency Range – 902 to 928 MHz, which is UHF.

Answer: Proposers are allowed to submit solutions with frequencies including or outside of these ranges.

2. Please confirm if an equal alternative for the RFID/AVI be accepted - as long as the provider meets the frequency requirements - so the product options are not restricted to one of the below-mentioned brands. The Glossary states the RFID technology for AVI is such as E-ZPass, E-ZPass®Plus, HID™, or PayPass™.

Answer: Proposers are allowed to submit solutions outside of the brands listed.

3. Please confirm all Shuttle lanes are reversable – thus two AVI reader per lane, or if the Economy Parking Main Exit, Economy Parking West Exit, and Economy Parking Main Lot Exit to Covered Parking are exit only – thus requiring only one AVI per lane.

Answer: As per RFP page 34 of Exhibit A items a. through d., those locations should be reversable.

4. Can you confirm the total quantity of transponders?

Answer: As answered in Addendum 1, Question 9, the total quantity of transponders is not to exceed 25.

5. Is the LPR solution being considered as an alternative to the AVI/RFID or a separate alternate solution?

Answer: The LPR solution is listed as an Add Alternate #7 (4.7 LPR System).

6. Please extend the Proposal Due Date by at least twenty (20) days.

Answer: At this time, we are not extending the Proposal Due Date past Thursday, February 9, 2023.
